Historical releases caused radioactive (plutonium, americium) contamination within and outside its boundaries. The contamination primarily resulted from releases from the 903 Pad drum storage area – wind-blown plutonium that leaked from barrels of radioactive waste – and ...

Processes Gamma irradiation. Gamma irradiation is produced from the radioisotopes cobalt-60 and caesium-137, which are derived by neutron bombardment of cobalt-59 and as a nuclear source by-product, respectively. Cobalt-60 is the most common source of gamma rays for food irradiation in commercial scale facilities as it is water insoluble and hence has little risk of environmental contamination ...
